

#### Swim Lessons

The City of Leesburg is an official provider of American Red Cross Learn-To-Swim lessons. Group lessons are offered May to November, for participants from 6 months to adults.

For our Summer sessions (June and July) we will have 4 classes per time slot and each class will meet 8-30 minute lessons. Our Fall (August – November) and Spring (March to May) we will offer limited classes and they will have 6-30 minute classes and they will have 6-30 minute classes.

The format is as follows:

Spring and Fall: Twice a week for three weeks. (evening times only)

Summer: Monday through Thursday for two weeks, broken into mornings and evenings. Two sessions per month. All group lessons and registrations are held at the Leesburg Aquatic Center.

#### LESSON REGISTRATION

Registration must be done in person on or after the registration date listed. Swimmers must be present to be tested by one of our instructors prior to registering for a class. You **do not** need a swim test for Parent Child or Adult.

#### SWIM TEST INSTRUCTIONS

To get a swim test – simply go to the Leesburg Aquatic Center (when they are open) and let the lifeguard know you need a swim test for swim lessons. This process takes about 5 minutes and does not cost anything. You do not need an appointment just notify the staff at admissions that you will need a swim test.

#### CLASS DESCRIPTION:

The following are descriptions for each class:

#### INFANT & PARENT AQUATICS

Our infant and parent class is a parent and child class designed for those starting at 6 months up to 3 years of age. The class is not a "survival swim" class. Instead, the class is set to create a positive environment for your little future swimmer. Classes are fun while introducing swim skills through games and songs.

#### <u>PRE</u>

The PRE classes are for those participants between the ages of 3-5 years of age. Pre Classes are broken down into three classes: Pre A, Pre B, Pre C. If your participant is taking swim lessons for the first time or does not know how to swim independently yet (without floaties), they should sign up for the Pre A. To be eligible for Pre B and C, participants must have a Pre A certificate, or swim test clearing them for that class.

#### <u>LEVELS</u>

The Levels classes are for those participants between the ages of 6-13 years of age. Levels are broken down into five classes: Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 and Pre-Lakers (Level 5). If your participants taking swim lessons for the first time or does not know how to swim independently yet (without floaties), they should sign up for the Level 1. To be eligible for the higher classes, participants must have a Level 1 certificate, or a swim test clearing them for that class.

# Become a lífeguard!

The City of Leesburg offers multiple American Red Cross lifeguard certification classes. The American Red Cross Lifeguarding course provides entry-level lifeguard participants who are 15 years and older with the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services take over. At the beginning of the course each candidate will need to perform a 300-yard continuous swim using the front crawl or breaststroke, tread for 2 minutes without support and without stopping, and swim 20 yards then surface dive to retrieve a 10 pound brick, then return to the starting point with the brick and exit the pool. The blended lifeguarding course require 7-10 hours of online course work that must be completed to receive a certification. The certification is a nationally recognized certification that will allow participants to become a lifeguard for any that accepts the American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certification.

### Lifeguard Re-Certification

The American Red Cross Lifeguard/CPR/First Aid/AED certification lasts for two years and to continue their certification, lifeguards must take a recertification course. The course is a summary of the full lifeguarding course an each lifeguard will need to complete the prerequisites, be able to perform all rescues and then pass the final written and in water tests. The City of Leesburg offers a re-certification class one time per year.

### Water Safety Instructor

The American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor course is to train instructor candidates who are 16 years and older to teach courses and presentations in the American Red Cross swimming and Water Safety program by developing their understanding of how to use the course materials, how to conduct training sessions and how to evaluate participants' progress. Each candidate should be able to complete the following prerequisites; front crawl for 25 yards, back crawl for 25 yards, breaststroke for 25 yards, elementary backstroke for 25 yards, sidestroke for 25 yards, butterfly for 15 yards, float or scull for 1 minute and tread water for 1 minute. The blended course requires 6-9 hours of online course work that must be completed to receive a certification. Once completed the participants are eligible to teach swim lessons.





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# **Parks & Recreation Polices**

### Sportsmanship:

Cheering in a positive fashion, for both sides, is highly encouraged. Cheer for a good effort as much as a good performance. Make only positive comments about children – yours or others. Always show respect for all involved in the game including coaches, players, opponents, opposing fans and officials. Our programs are recreational leagues with fun as the primary emphasis. All coaches are volunteers, and we should all appreciate their efforts and support them...thus setting a good example for the children. All participants in Leesburg Parks and Recreation programs, including players, parents, spectators, coaches and officials, will treat each other with courtesy and respect at all times, no exceptions!

### Cancellations:

Unfortunately from time to time games, activities, or programs must be cancelled due to weather conditions and/or other unforeseen circumstances. Cancellations will be communicated in the following order:

- 1. The Recreation Department will notify all head coaches (If is a program with coaches). Coaches will in turn contact their players.
- 2. LRD Staff will post on the official Leesburg Recreation Facebook page.
- LRD staff will create a message on a dedicated cancelation phone line (352) 728-9786 extension 3232

The City of Leesburg will attempt to make-up any games or programs that are rained out, but please note that sometimes schedules will not permit such make-up dates.

### Dues/Refunds:

All fees are due at the time of registration. Cash, check, and credit/debit are accepted. Checks should be made out to Leesburg Parks and Recreation. Refunds will only be given for withdrawals from an activity prior to the start of the event and/or prior to the purchasing of uniforms. There are no refunds after a program has started. Refund checks will be mailed and can take up to three weeks to process. There is a \$25 fee for returned checks.

### Past Due Balances:

Residents with past due accounts are not permitted to reserve any facilities, register for programs until their balance is paid in full.

### <u>Scholarships:</u>

The Leesburg Recreation strives to provide quality, low cost, programs to all residents in Leesburg. We want to ensure that everyone has an equal opportunity to participate in any of our programs. Scholarships are available for those eligible. To be eligible for a Recreation Scholarships you must be a City of Leesburg resident. Scholarship forms are available at on the LRD website, or at the Leesburg Recreation Complex (City Gym). Applicants must provide proof of residence along with financial information.

### Registration:

Nothing hurts a program more than missed deadlines. Please register early to ensure we can operate the program in an organized manner. Registering before the deadline also helps ensure that we have enough time to order any necessary equipment or supplies for the program. We cannot guarantee there will be any openings after the deadline has passed. Once a program is full, participants may choose to be placed on a waiting list.

### <u>Team Placement:</u>

Evenly matched teams ALWAYS create the best experience for program participants. To create evenly matched teams volunteer coaches may choose one assistant coach. Players can request special assignments, but these requests are not guaranteed. All other players are selected via a draft system\*. Parents/players will be notified of their team assignment by your assigned coach. \*Due to age and ability some teams are formed at the discretion of the Recreation Department. \*\*Final team assignment is at the sole discretion of the Leesburg Recreation Department.

### <u>Communication:</u>

Communication is key to every program or activity conducted by the Recreation Department. Email and phone correspondence are the primary methods of communication used by Recreation Staff. Social media pages are not monitored 24/7 and are not an effective way to have ongoing communication. Venetian Cove Marina is a full service marina located in Venetian Cove just off beautiful Lake Harris. Customers have the convenience of having their boat in the water ready to go when they are. No need to stress about congested ramps, trailering your boat, launching and re-loading your boat, or parking issues. Our friendly staff provides customers and visitors with top notch customer service. The Venetian Cove Marina is owned and operated by the City of Leesburg and is designated a Clean, Resilient Marina and a Clean Boatyard by the DEP.

Storage Services & Rates:

Length for boats are biased off of the boats bow to transom. This length does not include engines.

#### Dry Storage:

Dry storage can accommodate boats 16' to 24' with 8.6' beams or less. Dry Storage allows you to plan ahead and schedule a time that you wish to take your boat out. The Marina staff will have your boat in the water when you arrive. At the request of the renter, marina staff can also have your boat gassed up and ready to ride. When you return to the marina the boat will be put back into its own dry storage rack out of the water. All launches are covered by your monthly payments. Dry storage rental also includes the option to put your boat on a wash rack for washing and detailing.

We have several different rates which are charged monthly for our Dry storage:

Sleepy Hollow Complex continues to be a national and regional draw for NCAA Softball and youth baseball/softball events.

Sleepy Hollow was still home to 31 weekend baseball/softball tournaments which brought over 100,000 visitors to Leesburg and surrounding area.

Reservations for 2024 include 33 weekends reserved along with welcoming THE Spring Games are back to Sleepy Hollow with Division 1 softball in February and Division 3 softball in March.

Visitor numbers are projected to reach over 300,000 visitors to Leesburg and the surrounding area due to these events.

The 2024 estimated economic impact for these rentals is approximately \$4.5M.

The City of Leesburg partners with Lake County and The Greater Orlando Sports Commission to host many national and global professional fishing events on Ski Beach in Venetian Gardens.

Past events have included Bassmasters Team Tournaments, Bassmasters Individual tournaments, Major League Fishing, Florida BASS Nation High School Tournaments, and FLW Tournaments among other organizations.

The Chain of Lakes are a nationally renowned body of water known for largemouth bass and crappie fishing. These events attract up to 300 anglers from all across the county, and even internationally.

Anglers often spend multiple nights in Leesburg hotels. Fishing events have an estimated economic impact of \$500,000 to \$2M per event.

Scheduled 2024 events include: MLF, MLF Big 5 Gator Division, Bassmasters Elite, Florida BASS Nation, and others.
