Dear Ms. Cooper:

In response to Scott Christiansen's letter dated January 25, 2012, we have reviewed the proposed Ordinance (identified on page 5 as dm/lrb/gen/01-24-12.ord) amending the Plan's definition of Credited Service, and also amending the Optional Forms of Benefits section. We have determined that its adoption will have no impact on the assumptions used in determining the funding requirements of the program.

Because the changes do not result in a change in the valuation results, it is our opinion that a formal Actuarial Impact Statement is not required in support of its adoption. However, since the Division of Retirement must be aware of the current provisions of all public pension programs, it is recommended that you send a copy of this letter and a copy of the fully executed Ordinance to the following office:
