## ATTACHMENT A SCOPE OF SERVICES Leesburg International Airport for Security Fence Project

### **Project Description**

On 07/25/2011, the City Commission authorized execution of Task Order No. 5 with Hanson Professional Services Inc. for the purpose of securing engineering services in connection with a project to provide design and bidding services for security fencing only at the Leesburg International Airport.

The preliminary plans were prepared and submitted to the Airport, Airport Tenants, FDOT and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for review and comment. After several meetings and discussions regarding various alignments it was decided that the best solution in providing security was to install two (2) automated vehicle gates along Airport Blvd. using existing materials from Gate No. 4 and encloses the Airport Operations Area (AOA) north of Airport Blvd. with new security fencing. This solution will secure the AOA north of Airport Blvd. for the aircraft hangars and eliminate the need for the existing 80 foot wide high maintenance vehicle/aircraft Gate No. 4.

As a result of the above, on 05/29/12 the City Commission authorized execution of Amendment 1 to Task Order No. 5 for the purpose of providing engineering design services associated with the new gate installations on Airport Blvd. and other security measures as defined in the task order amendment.

The design was completed and project was advertised for construction bids in December 2012 and a contract for construction was awarded to Electric Services Inc. on 02/11/13.

On 02/22/13 the project pre-construction meeting was held. At that meeting, the City requested Hanson Professional Services Inc. and Electric Services Inc. submit proposals to revise the gate installations on Airport Blvd. from a single cantilever gates that spans across both lanes of traffic to swing gates that span across each individual lane of traffic.

### **Scope of Work**

This task order amendment provides engineering services to revise the construction plans and specifications for the new swing gates.

### **Compensation**

The total lump sum fee is \$5,030.00 See Attachment "B" for details.
