

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LEESBURG, FLORIDA,
AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-13 BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL AND CAPITAL
PROJECTS FUNDS FOR THE THIRD QUARTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Commission of the City of Leesburg adopted a budget for the Fiscal Year 2012-13 on September 24, 2012, which they felt was in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Leesburg, and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the current budget for Fiscal Year 2012-13 to provide funds for various projects as adopted at City Commission meetings, and

WHEREAS, such action was not anticipated in the original 2012-13 annual budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEESBURG, FLORIDA:

SECTION I.

Pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, and all other applicable laws, the following amounts for use by the various funds during Fiscal Year 2012-13 as reflected below, including all modifications or amendments made during this meetings, are hereby adopted as increases/decreases to the original budget for Fiscal Year 2012-13 for the City of Leesburg, Florida:
