

City of Leesburg Fire Fee Schedule
Authorized: January 14, 2008 by Resolution No.
Implementation date: April 1, 2008

I. FEES RELATED TO NEW CONSTRUCTION, AND GROWTH

The fire department is not required to review or inspect single family detached or duplex residential structures. These buildings are exempted from the fees listed below.

- A. Fire plans reviews: \$.04 per sq. ft. \$50. minimum
Fee includes all fire inspections for new construction, with exception for the systems identified below.

- B. Fire sprinkler systems \$150.

- C. Fire suppression / hood systems \$100.

- D. Fire alarm systems \$100.

- E. Significant revisions \$ 75.

II. FEES RELATED TO REQUIRED FIRE INSPECTIONS (LICENSING, ETC.)

There will be no charge for normal annual fire inspections; however, the reinspections fees will apply if there is no attempt to correct violations and second or greater reinspections are required.

- A. Fire inspections required for licensing
\$25 per 5,000 sq. ft., \$50 minimum charge

- B. Re-inspections
 - First: no charge
 - Second: \$ 50.
 - Third and additional: \$100. each

III. FEES RELATED TO FIRE INSPECTIONS AFTER HOURS, WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS

Fire inspections may be conducted after hours, on weekends or on holidays subject to the availability of a certified Fire Inspector. These inspections are conducted for the convenience of the owner/contractor/developer in order to expedite a project, license, etc.

- The fee for fire inspections after hours, Monday through Friday, will amount to \$55. per hour for a minimum of two hours in addition to any normal inspection fee.
