The City is currently reviewing a proposed rezoning application for a 8.72-acre property, which is proposed to change from City of Leesburg Public to City of Leesburg Estate Density Residential (RE-1). As the School Board of Lake County's authorized representative, I am forwarding the School Board's comments to your attention so they can be included with your planning report. The School Board of Lake County Florida believes the proposed rezoning will have an adverse impact on Lake County Public Schools. The following School Board comments reflect enrollment data as of June 6, 2008, and student generation rates from the Impact Fee Study.

The proposed rezoning has the potential to add eight new single-family dwelling units that will contribute three new students to the Lake County School system. Based on current school attendance zones, schools that will be adversely affected by the proposed rezoning and their current permanent capacity status are as follows:
