

**TASK ORDER NUMBER 1 TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
ON A CONTINUING BASIS**

**WITNESSTH:**

**WHEREAS**, on November 24, 2008, the CITY and the PROFESSIONAL previously entered into an Agreement for PROFESSIONAL Surveying Services on a Continuing Basis (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"). The Agreement is referenced herein as though set forth in full text.

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and the PROFESSIONAL desire to enter into a Written Amendment for Task Order Number 1.

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained in this Agreement, the CITY and the PROFESSIONAL do hereby agree as set forth below:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. The Parties agree to the scope of work and budget pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit "A".

## EXHIBIT "A"

**SCOPE OF WORK:** Provide DIXIE AVENUE (SR 44) UTILITY SURVEYING SERVICES in accordance with Chapter 6 1617-6 F.A.C. for the amount of \$44,935.00 to include the following:

**PROJECT LIMITS:**

Beginning on the NORTH side of Dixie Avenue, 50 feet WEST of Canal Street, run east along the NORTH side of Dixie Avenue to 50 feet WEST of its intersection with Lake Street; survey both sides of Dixie Avenue from 50 feet WEST of Lake Street to 400 feet EAST of Lake Street; then the survey will continue along the SOUTH and EAST side of Dixie Avenue to Main Street; then survey along the SOUTH side of Main Street to the cul-de-sac adjacent to US 441. The survey will extend from edge of pavement on required side of Dixie Avenue to 20 feet beyond right of way.

1. Horizontal control in NAD'83(1990) and vertical control in NAVD'88 will be run throughout the site and will serve as basis of survey data.
2. Survey points in SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH; RANGE 24 EAST will be found and tied to aid in parcel line determination for future legal descriptions.
3. Individual parcel property comers will be found and tied to aid in parcel determination.
4. Dixie Avenue centerline of right of way control points will be recovered. Missing points, if any, will be set using 1999 FDOT Survey Reference Points set outside existing right of way. Centerline points will be used to determine right of way in areas to be surveyed. The developed right of way will be staked at 300 foot intervals in survey area as an aid to utility locations.
5. Horizontally locate and field mark all public subsurface utilities within project limits; average 3 utilities for length of project.
6. Coordinate Sunshine One Call and utility locates to include supplemental calls to each locator to expedite the field marking of each subsurface utility as required by law.
7. All conflicting utility crossings will be vacuum excavated, exposed, verified and all necessary information recorded (Test Holes). All paralleling utilities (average 3) will be vacuum excavated every 300 feet; 28 cross-sections.
8. Perform a Topographic Survey within the project limits to include everything above ground, subsurface utilities and drainage features. All will be included in a single survey drawing and digital file.
9. Survey drawings of the project area will be provided at 1" = 20' scale. Digital files in AutoCAD will also be provided. The final product will be four (4) certified prints.
10. SSMC will coordinate with the title company for deeds along the route to be surveyed.
