Residential solid waste and hand commercial route will move
from Friday to Tuesday.

No change for dumpster service for any Holiday

**If your recycling day falls on a Holiday it will be picked up
on your next scheduled recycling day.**

Solid Waste is a division of the City of Leesburg Public Works Department. This division is responsible for collecting and transporting all of the garbage generated by homes, businesses, government operations, & schools located within the Leesburg City limits. In addition the division collects recyclable materials from homes.

Residential customers are provided a 90 gallon container for their household garbage & small amounts of yard waste. This material is collected twice each week. Some residential condominiums and apartments are provided with dumpster service, which is serviced on a schedule based upon the volume of refuse generated by the residents.

In addition to garbage & yard waste collection twice a week, the City collects recyclables once a week from all residential customers. Consult the schedule on the back to determine your pick-up schedule or contact the Solid Waste office at 352-728-9878.

Business, commercial and government customers have a number of options to choose from, depending upon the type of business operation & the location of that operation. Some of these customers, because of the small volume of garbage generated, are able to select a similar type of curbside collection as residential customers. However, most business related customers, are provided dumpster services & collection options that range from once per week to six times per week.

Electronic (E-Waste) recycling is any unwanted electronic product & equipment including computers, cell phones, tv's and other consumer electronics. To dispose of

E-Waste in the City of Leesburg customer service area you may do the following: 1.) Call 352-728-9878 to schedule a pickup, place the items **beside** your container on your first pickup day. 2.) Contact Lake County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center at 352-343-3776 for the nearest drop off location.

The City provides **Bulk** collection of certain household items & large piles of yard waste by appointment. Contact the Solid Waste office to schedule a pick-up of these large items or to determine if your items are considered to be classified as a bulk item. In some cases a fee will be charged for these services.

The following items are **ACCEPTED** for recycling at this time:

Empty glass drink bottles

Empty plastic drink and laundry bottles

Empty glass food jars

Empty plastic food jars

Newspapers only

Empty tin & aluminum food & drink cans

Please **DO NOT** place broken glass bottles or jars in recycling bin

Some items **NOT ACCEPTED** for recycling at this time:

No hard cover books, Styrofoam, coat hangers, aluminum pie tins or roasting pans, plastic bags, containers that contained

petroleum products, window panes, or any food items.

These items should be placed in your garbage container for pickup on your regularly scheduled garbage pickup days.

Please be advised that all garbage and recycling containers **must be at curbside by 6:30 AM** Your container will be picked up between the hours of 6:30 am & 5:00 pm. The routes can change on a week to week basis so it is imperative that you have your containers out by 6:30 am on your scheduled days. The weather, traffic, etc. can affect the time that your container is picked up.

Chapter 11 GARBAGE AND REFUSE*

Sec. 11-31. City not responsible for refuse collection from vacant property or waste building materials.

....."Lawn services and tree surgeons are responsible for removal of all leaves, grass, branches, stumps and other materials which result from the operation of their businesses. If an owner or tenant requests the city to remove and dispose of such refuse accumulation, such owner or tenant shall pay to the city a fee based upon the total cost of labor, materials and equipment utilized therefore, the minimum fee for which shall be established by resolution of the city commission."

Sec. 11-32. Collection and disposal facilities established as public utility; collection generally; permits for private collectors.

(c) *Collection generally; permit to use private collectors; exceptions.* (2) Commercial tree trimmers, landscapers & lawn maintenance operators shall dispose of all waste produced by their operation.
