Utility Easement

RESERVED FOR RECORDING

THIS EASEMENT given the 1ST day of November, 2011, by BEACON COLLEGE, INC., whose address is 105 East Main Street, Leesburg, FL 34748, hereafter referred to as Grantor, to THE CITY OF LEESBURG, FLORIDA, whose address is P.O. Box 490630, Leesburg, FL 34749-0630, hereafter referred to as Grantee,

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations, in hand paid and tendered unto Grantor, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, a perpetual easement over and across the following described real property:

AS DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED

for the purpose of construction, installation, repair, maintenance, replacement and improvement of underground or above ground utilities, including but not limited to water, sewer, reuse water, natural gas, electricity, cable television, fiber optics, and telecommunications. In addition, as to Easement "B" on the attached description, Grantor conveys to Grantee an easement over the West 10 feet of the aforementioned Easement "B" for construction, maintenance, improvement and replacement of a sidewalk. If Grantee damages any surface improvements in its use of this easement, it shall repair any such damage at its expense, and restore the improvements to substantially the same condition they were in prior to the damage. Grantee is also given an irrevocable license, for so long as this Easement remains in effect, to cross the adjoining real property owned by Grantor, for the purpose of conducting any activities permitted by this Easement provided that such right of passage shall not interfere substantially with Grantor's use of its adjoining property.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever. Grantor does hereby warrant the title to the interests conveyed to Grantee hereunder and will defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

As used herein, the term "Grantor" shall refer to that person, or those persons, so named above, and shall be interpreted as being singular or plural, and shall be considered to have the person, number and gender appropriate to the context of the named individuals or entities.
